



Trinity Community Church Sermon Discussion Questions
Remember Your Baptism!
1 Peter 3:18-24

Below are discussion questions designed to facilitate a deeper study of the passage. It is our hope that the word of God would “dwell richly in us” (Col 3:16) and bring transformation and fruit in our lives for the glory of God.

1. In the Flood Story, God starts over with creation and creates a new earth. How does Genesis show the insufficiency of this new world in Genesis 9:20-21? What are the parallels between the story of the Fall in Genesis 3 and Genesis 9?
2. Why do you think Peter reminded his readers of the story of the flood in 1 Peter 3:18? If the flood brought 8 people safely through the judgment of the flood, what reality does baptism point to that leads sinful people safely through?
3. Baptism is an external, visible sign that we are connected to the resurrection life of Jesus Christ. When we remember our baptism, we should remember what it points to. Read 1 Peter 1:3-9. What are the specific reasons as believers we can have hope (v.3), we can rejoice (v.6), and we can have joy (v.8)?
4. If it is appropriate in your group, consider sharing your memories of baptism. How did God use your baptism in your life? How can remembering what baptism represents serve as an encouragement during the trials of life?
