



Trinity Community Church Sermon Discussion Questions
When God Remembers
Genesis 8:1-22

Below are discussion questions designed to facilitate a deeper study of the passage. It is our hope that the word of God would “dwell richly in us” (Col 3:16) and bring transformation and fruit in our lives for the glory of God.

- 1) The judgment of God (especially like we see in the flood) is one of the most difficult things for modern unbelievers (and even many believers) to overcome in order to have faith in God. What would you say to someone who would question the goodness of a God who could cause something like the flood?

- 2) 'God remembered Noah' (Genesis 8:1) is the turning point of the flood narrative. It is a reminder that God can often appear late to act, but that He does not forget His people. Spend some time sharing in your group times when 'God remembered you' and His faithful grace made an appearance in a time of need.

- 3) Given what Tim said about worship (and how it ties with obedience, faithfulness, trust, and thankfulness towards God), reflect on your own worship right now. Where are you strong? Where are you weak? Is your life high on obedience but low on thankfulness and joy towards God? Where do you think God would most like to see you grow in your worship of Him?
